Qualifying Classes: Please indicate that the class is to count for qualifying in Great American/USDF Championships by placing a Q after the class number. Please indicate that the class is to count for Qualifying in the I-35 Series Championships by placing a Q35 after the class number. Qualifying will not require a separate ride.

Post Entries & Changes:

Before Closing: Will be taken as scheduling permits, with \$10 added fee per class. Horse/Rider change fee of \$25

After Closing: Will be taken as scheduling permits, with \$25 late fee. Horse/Rider change fee of \$25

During the Show: Will be taken as scheduling permits, with \$10 added fee per class. Horse/Rider change fee of \$25. **The Show Secretary's office must be notified by 3:00PM the day prior to the requested ride change.**

Confirmation/Ride Times: Confirmation of entry will be via email. All e-mail addresses must be clearly printed. Ride times & updates will be posted at thehorsefarm.com. (look under "Quick Links" on the home page). Entries taken on a first come, first served basis and may close early if time limits for judges are filled. Remaining entries received before closing date will be placed on a wait list. This show is ONE ring – ride times may begin early in the morning & go until early evening.

Awards: Divisions (Jr/YR, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as open. Riders may enter only one division per class. Placings thru 6th place. No awards for qualifying class. Championship and Reserves awarded for the highest percentage at each USEF level in each division & for all FEI levels. (Young Horse classes excluded). Freestyles will be excluded from all Championship and Reserve awards. Top Adult Amateur in Second Level Test Three on Sunday will be awarded the Dover Medal.

Stabling and Tack Stalls: All stalls are Permanent. Main Barn 12 x 12, full doors, (Very Limited, 1st come basis) are \$110 Thurs AM thru Sunday 7 PM with initial bedding. All other stalls with gate doors are \$90 Thurs AM thru Sunday 7PM with no initial bedding included. Bedding may be purchased at \$8.50 per bag. Jump Outs allowed at \$35 per horse (Competition horses only) for duration of show and must park in designated area. Check with show office on Friday for parking assignments. Non-competing horses pay fee of \$25 each & all other stabling & Jump out fees apply.

Directions: From KS Turnpike (I-35 heading North): Exit Wichita East (Kellogg). Go East on US54 for 11.5 miles to **mile marker 233**. From KS Turnpike (I-35 heading South): Exit Andover exit, turn right (east) after toll booth and go 4 miles to Santa Fe Lake Rd., turn right (south) and go 3 miles to US54, turn left (east) and go approx. 1 mile to **mile marker 233**. From I-135 North heading south: Exit North East Expressway (Exit 10) approx. 9 miles to Hwy 54 (Augusta). Go east on Hwy 54 approx. 9 miles to **mile marker 233**. Briar Fox Farm is on North side of Hwy 54.

Accommodations: Within 2 miles of show grounds: Augusta Inn (316-775-5979), Lehr's Motel (316-775-6327). Within 6 miles: Holiday Inn Express (316-733-8833). Within 11 miles: Club House Inn & Suites (316-684-1111). **RV's/Campers:** Are welcome but each must pay a fee of \$50 for the weekend on their entry form. This fee allows electrical hookups (30amp & limited 50amp) and access to water in some locations. Our space is very limited for hookups so reserve early by phoning manager/secretary to secure a convenient location. Tents are allowed at no charge as long as they do not use electrical hookup.

Footing and Arenas: All tests will be ridden in the large arena (60 meters long X 20 meters wide). Competition and warm-up arena (indoor 60m x 20m) is sand footing. Grass footing for lunging-check with show office as to location. No foot traffic in warm-up areas. Trainers, coaches, parents, grooms & friends may assist competition riders ONLY from the sidelines of the warm-up arenas. Arenas will be watered and harrowed throughout the weekend & a schedule will be posted for your convenience. Competition arena will be available for schooling (weather permitting) Friday afternoon & evening until 8 pm. Indoor warm up arena will close at 9pm on Friday and 7 pm on Saturday.

Refunds: All fees of cancelled entries refunded less office fee prior to closing date by 9pm CST if submitted **in writing**. No refunds after closing date. You are responsible to confirm that your cancellation is received. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any Championship or qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents or emergencies.

Musical Freestyles: We will provide an adequate amplifier system that can be used outside providing your equipment can be hooked up to the amplifier. Call manager/secretary for details before entering. On Friday before 6 PM, schedule your sound check with secretary. In order to enter a freestyle class at any level, a horse/rider combination must have received a minimum score of 60% in the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level at a USEF Recognized Competition. A photocopy of the test verifying eligibility must be submitted with the entry for a freestyle class. Does not apply to competitors in NAYRC qualifiers.

Other: **DOGS** ALLOWED WITH PROOF OF RABIES VACCINATION AND THAT AT ALL TIMES ARE KEPT ON LEASHES. UNATTENDED DOGS ARE SUBJECT TO A \$50 FINE PER OCCURANCE. **Current Coggins** within 12 months needed on all horses. **Horses not entered in the show** may not be brought onto the show grounds without PRIOR arrangements/payments. Preference will be given to competition horses. **Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest**, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. **Concessions** on grounds Saturday and Sunday during normal show hours. **Show Schedule and Ride Time Conflicts:** It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after viewing the schedule at thehorsefarm.com. **Classes may not necessarily be run in order listed in the prize lists/Class Schedules.** **Show Office Hours:** Friday-Open 1PM to 6:30PM, Saturday-Open 7AM to 1 Hr. after last class of day, Sunday-Open 7AM to 1 Hr after last class of day. Phone Number during Show Office Open Hours: 316-648-4705. **No Shows:** All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride of the show will be considered a scratch for the duration of the show and time slots may be filled. Phone calls will be accepted as notification *only during Show Office Hours*. Exhibitors enter with this understanding and agreement. **Arena Sizes:** Standard arena is 20m x 60m. Small arena is 20m x 40m. **Sharps Disposal:** Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. **Rider Emergency Contact Info:** On entry form, Rider must provide: 1. Name of Contact & Relationship. 2. Phone number for Contact. Space to provide this info is located just under the signature blocks on page 2 of the entry form. **Horse Health Papers:** Riders should be aware that Interstate Health Papers are required to be in your vehicle when attending shows not within their home state. Some states also require health papers when transporting between facilities within the same state. Check with your state veterinarian.

**** Opportunity Classes:** Any Opportunity Classes offered must include "Opportunity" in the class name. These classes must follow all USEF Dressage Division rules and applicable USEF General Rules, including dress and saddler. Opportunity Classes must be judged by USEF licensed judges or FEI Dressage judges. If entered in opportunity classes restricted to amateurs, riders are required to have an amateur status with USEF or pay the \$30 non-member amateur card fee. Horses and/or riders/drivers/handlers entered in Opportunity Classes can cross enter into the rated/recognized classes at this competition. If you cross enter, all applicable fees and membership requirements will apply to those classes. Opportunity classes cannot be used as qualifying classes for the Great American/USDF Regional Championships. Freestyles or Test of choice classes may not be offered as Opportunity classes. Riders and Owners entered only in these classes are exempt from both USDF and USEF membership requirements and are not required to pay a non-member fee but are required to list the Federation Membership number if the participant is a member. Horses entered only in these classes: Are exempt from the Federation fee, including the Equine Drugs and Medication fee. Are not required to have either a USEF or USDF Horse Identification (HID) or Recording Number but are to list the HID or Recording number if the horse has been assigned this number. Horses entered only in these classes are still subject to and must comply with the Drugs and Medication rules and are subject to drug testing.

I hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless USDF, its instructors, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities. I also hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless the competition licensee, show management, show staff, show committee and members, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities.

Federation Entry Agreement Effective 12/1/09

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and if applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE to be bound by all applicable Federation Rules and all terms and provisions of this entry blank.
